

## Xerox Photocopying Machine and Paper Shredder Donation

Sampaloc Elementary School is located in a densely populated area of Sucat, Paranaque City with a student body population of 2,240 and 52 permanent teachers.

Most of the students of Sampaloc Elementary School come from low-income families, which could account for fact that 27%, or one-third of their student's population is classified as wasted, severely wasted and/or undernourished.

Aside from problems with their students' poor nutrition, Sampaloc Elementary School faces other problems, such as low literacy scores, lack of equipment and facilities, and lack of training for many of the teachers.

Springboard Foundation is currently working closely with Sampaloc Elementary Schools and other concerned organizations and individuals to solve these issues.
